



Resort Charge Authorization 2016/2017

By signing below or by completing the resort charge authorization process on the skiwhitefish.com estore website, you are authorizing Whitefish Mountain Resort to store your credit card information electronically. This enables authorized Season Passes and/or Direct to Lift Cards listed to charge goods and services at participating resort locations. You are agreeing to pay for all goods and services charged to your credit card using Resort Charge. If the card on file is to expire before SEPTEMBER 2017 it is your responsibility to contact WMR with new information. **Declined charges may be assessed a fee of \$25.** Direct to Lift Card holders will be charged the discounted lift ticket rate once per day for each day skied. Some restrictions may apply. You also agree to personally pay charges not accepted on your credit card. You may change the credit card on file at any time by contacting the Guest Information and Services Department or Online with the new credit card information.

If the Season Pass or Direct to Lift Card is lost or stolen, as the pass holder, you are required to contact the Guest Services and Information Center at 406-862-2900 to inactivate your lost or stolen pass.

Please note you may need to inform you credit card issuer of your participation in this program.
