### Aerial Adventure Park:

- Opened summer of 2012
- 5 courses: yellow, 2 green, blue and black (easiest to hardest)
- 10-15 "elements" on each course (suspended bridges, cable walk ways, nets, ladders, trapezes, tube traverses, zip lines, barrels, etc.)
- 60+ elements (not counting zip lines) and no two are alike
- Courses are 10-50 feet off the ground
- Participants go through each course independently wearing a full-body harness and be double secured into a cable system
- After a 15-20 minute briefing, participants will have 2 hours in the park
- Ages 7 & up
- Maximum weight is 265
- **Price: \$47 ages 13+; \$35 for 12 & under** (Late arrival 3:30-4:30 pm \$39, \$29 for 12 & under)

### Zip Line Tours:

*Longest zip line tour (7 Zip) and the Second Longest zip line tour (5 Zip) in Montana!*

- Opened summer 2009
- Added 2 additional zips (AdrenaLine and Highline) spring 2010
- Heaven extended spring 2011
- Inspiration added spring 2012
- 8,425 feet, or 1.6 miles (2.7 kilometers) of zipping fun
- All zips have dual-tracks
- Speeds can reach up to 50 MPH (80 km/h)
- Lines are up to 300 feet (91 meters) high
- Longest Zips are 1,900 feet (579 meters)
- Two tour options: 7 Zip ( 2.5 hours) or 5 Zip (2 hours)
- All participants must be 54 inches tall
- Participants must weigh between 60 and 230 lbs (45-104 kilograms)
- Appropriate footwear required (Shoes with closed toes and closed heels are required)
- There is some hiking required in between zips
- Leash recommended for sunglasses, hats, cameras and other personal items
- **Participation not recommended** if you have back, neck or heart problems, high blood pressure, motion sickness or dizziness, as it may be aggravated by this adventure
- **Expectant mothers** should not ride
- No smoking, eating or drinking while on the tour
- Parties should check in no later than **20 minutes prior** to their tour start time
- Tours go out **rain or shine** (lightning excepted)

- 1,605 feet (489 meters) long
- 281 feet (86 meters) vertical drop
- 16 banked turns
- 2 dips
- Persons under 48" (122 centimeters) must ride with an adult
- **Price: \$8 for one ride or \$25 for 4 rides \$135 for 25 pack**

## Walk in the Treetops:

*One of the only walks of its kind in North America*

- Opened summer 2002
- A half mile (.8 kilometer) hike through beautiful sub-alpine forest led by expert forest interpreters
- A journey on a canopy boardwalk suspended up to 70 feet (21 meters) above the forest floor with spectacular views
- A safety harness and ropes are used to keep you safe
- A snack and water are provided
- Shoes with closed toes and closed heels are required
- Tour goes rain or shine, dress appropriately for the weather
- Tour is 2-2.5 hours long
- There is no age restriction, however participants must be at least 54 inches (137 centimeters) tall
- Participants must have a waist 42 inches (107 centimeters) or less
- **Price: \$49**

## Scenic Lift:

*Ride to Montana's only Mountaintop restaurant*

- Gondola/Chair 1 – 2,084 feet (635 meters) vertical, 14 minutes
- Chose from enclosed gondola car or open chair
- Summer scenic rides began in 1950 when single cars were added to the T-bar
- Scenic rides to the summit began in 1961 on Chair 1
- Gondola cars were added in 1989 and were used in Expo '86 the 1986 World's Fair held in Vancouver
